

NOTICE FOR THE CANDIDATES SHORTLISTED FOR THE
STENOGRAPHY TEST FOR THE POSTS OF JUNIOR
PARLIAMENTARY REPORTER (ENGLISH & HINDI)

Lists of candidates shortlisted for the stenography skill test for the posts of Junior Parliamentary Reporter (English) and Junior Parliamentary Reporter (Hindi) have been uploaded on the webpage of the Recruitment Cell on 10.02.2017. These lists are based on the percentile/marks obtained by the candidates in the preliminary examination.

2. Candidates are informed that they would be required to qualify stenography test at least at the rate of 140 w.p.m. Our past experience shows that candidates not proficient in stenography at high speed make a futile attempt by appearing at such stenography test and that leads to unnecessary wastage of time and resources of the candidates and of the Secretariat. Accordingly, shortlisted candidates who are not proficient in stenography and do not wish to appear at the stenography test are requested to communicate the same at the email id reporterexam2016@gmail.com by the 28th February, 2017. The candidates should send the email from their email id as indicated by them in their application forms. A candidate who opts not to appear in stenography test would be deemed to have withdrawn her/his candidature and accordingly, she/he would not be called for the subsequent stages of the exam for this post.

3. Further, candidates who possess shorthand speed of at least 120 words per minute and are desirous of undergoing stenography training of 140/160 w.p.m, are requested to communicate their willingness for undergoing stenography training at the aforesaid email latest by the 28th February 2017. Candidates are required to indicate their name, application No., Roll No. in the email.

4. Rajya Sabha Secretariat, subject to feasibility, may consider organizing in its premises at New Delhi, a free of cost stenography training of a short duration for shortlisted candidates who already possess shorthand speed of 120 w.p.m. or more. In order to be eligible for undergoing this training, the candidates would be required to pass the stenography test conducted by this Secretariat at a minimum speed of 120 words per minute.
